## Give a talk

- read a poem.



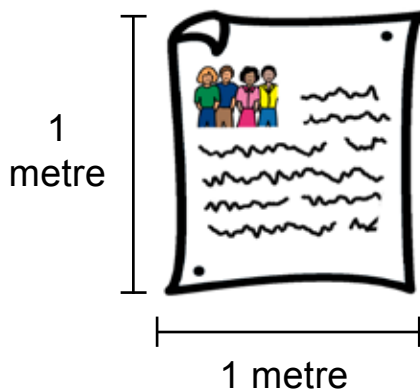
You will have up to **30 minutes** for your talk.

## Make a poster

You can offer to make a poster. You will need to talk to people about your poster.



Your poster must be 1 metre by 1 metre in size.

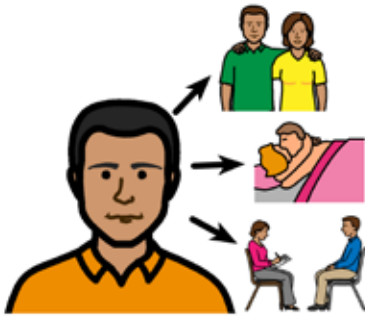
Your poster can have writing and pictures.

## Presentation topics



Your presentation **must** be about 1 of the 3 topics below

- Support from your religious community
- What do religion books say about disability?
- Study and research about God and religion.



Your presentation could also talk about

- love, for example, love you feel for friends, family or God
- empowerment - being in control of your life
- pastoral care, for example, help that you get from someone at your church, mosque or synagogue
- bioethics, for example, things that some people think are right and other people think are wrong
- sexuality.



## Write an abstract

To do a presentation at the conference, you must write an **abstract**. Your abstract will tell us a little bit about your presentation.

You should write up to 250 words.

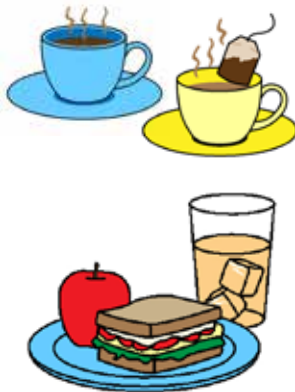

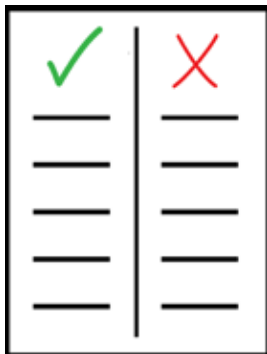


## How to register for the conference

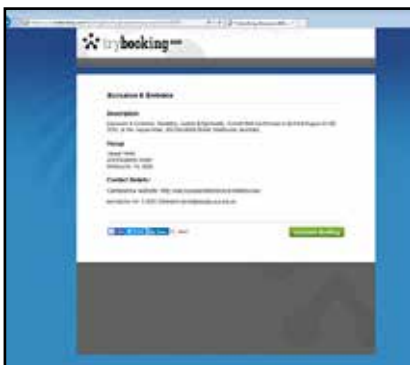

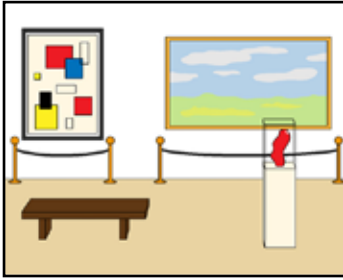
## Register and pay early

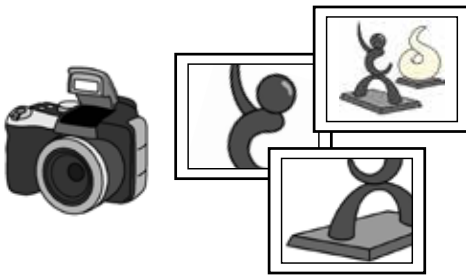
## Rules

### When you send your form



- You can enter 1 or 2 pieces of art.

- Your art must be your own.



- You **must** send us 3 photos of **each** piece of art. If you send the form by email, the photos should be **.jpg** files.

- You should write a few sentences about each piece of art.

- You can **not** enter your art **after** 17 June 2016.

- You can **not** change your entry.

## We will say Yes or No

We will write to you or email you and say



**Yes** - your art can be in the show.

or



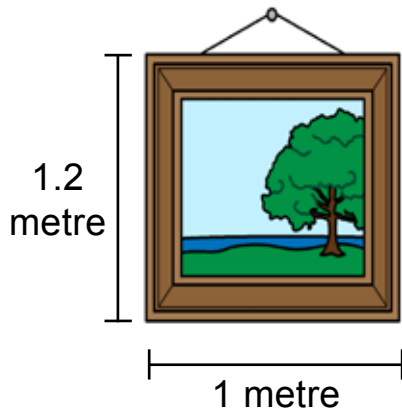
**No** - your art will **not** be in the art show this time.

## All art must be ready for the show



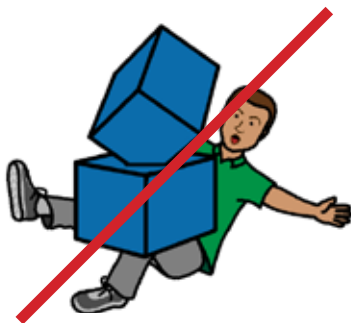
- All art must be ready
  - to hang
  - to display.
- Paintings must be dry.
- On the back right-hand corner of your art, you should write
  - your name and address
  - the name of your art
  - the **medium** - what you used to make the art, for example, oil paint or charcoal.





## Framed art

- Framed art must **not** be bigger than 1 metre wide and 1.2 metres high.
- D rings should be a third from the top of the painting.
- The wire apex should be 5cm from the top of the painting.



## We must be safe

- 3D art must be safe and strong. Your art must not break easily.
- All art must be easy for 1 person to carry or lift.
- Your art is **not** insured for the art show.
- We will be careful with your art. But there is a small chance your art might get broken or lost. If this happens, it is **not** our fault.



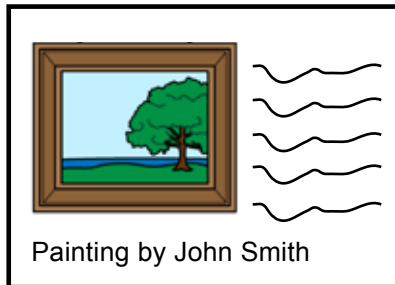


## **We might take photos of your art**

  - write your name
  - say you are the artist.



## **Do you want to sell your art?**
